

# BHS SAT PREP CLASS



**What:** A course designed to prepare juniors for SAT success

**When:** **MATH** Wednesdays 2:30-4:30pm OR 6:00-8:00pm  
**ENGLISH:** Tuesdays 6:00-8:00pm OR Thursdays 2:30-4:30 pm

**Location:** Braintree High School

**Cost:** \$125/for each class: English or Math

## **Course Description:**

Students will receive instruction both on SAT test-taking strategies and on required skills for the Critical Reading/Writing and Math sections of the SAT. Upon enrollment, students will receive a text of practice problems and practice tests. The course will be taught by trained teachers in both English and Math. Students who successfully complete both courses will earn one academic credit. The class is designed to further students' SAT test-taking skills and to promote their overall achievement on the SAT.
